- C) a boisterous complaining person behind you on a long checkout line
- D) a member of a club or group you belong to who tells dirty jokes and especially likes ones that mock “religious” people

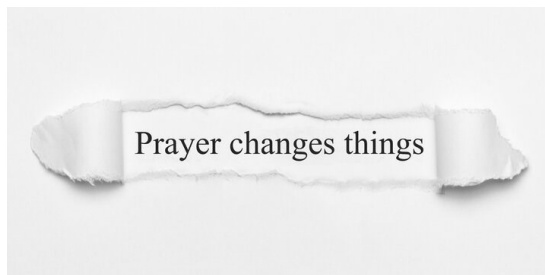
