

“Resistance Training” James 1:13-18

Are you aware of your sin patterns? When are you most likely to be tempted? In what ways are you likely to be tempted? What strategy have you placed in your life to keep you from succumbing to sin?

Read 1 Corinthians 10:13. What promise does God make to you when you are being tempted? How should you respond to temptation?

How is temptation like the birthing process? When does temptation become a sin? Why is replacing the temptation with the Word so important?

When we give in to temptation can we blame God? Can we say “the devil made me do it”? Why not? How does the Bible describe us as willing participants in all our sin?

How does our enemy know just the right time, location, and bait to set a trap for us? How must we use wisdom in our lives during this battle?

What is a cure for our temptation? How does understanding God’s abundance help us when we are facing temptation? How does believing that God will never withhold a good thing from us help us when we are tempted to sin?

What is an area of your life that you do not believe in God’s abundance and goodness? How is that false belief causing you to be tempted?

How significant is our identity in Christ Jesus during our battles with temptation? How important is it for us to be authentic with God?

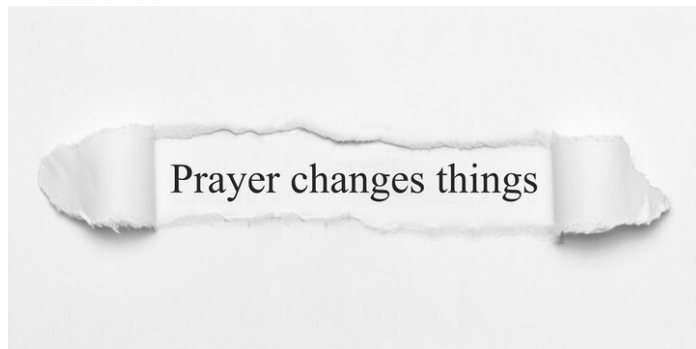
